

Course regulations

"INTEGRATED MODULAR TRAINING"

1. All the module classes are held according to the schedule and hours provided by the syllabus. A student is obliged to participate in the course with the assigned group of students.
2. Students' outer garments are to be left in the cloakroom.
3. The module consists of classes (15h)
4. Each student is allowed to **one authorized absence** during one semester. All absences must be authorized.
5. In case of two or more authorized absences, the student is obliged to **deliver an oral response concerning the material held during the classes and participate in the classes with another group** after consulting the date with the Head of the Unit. The student is required to attend the classes during the semester of the authorized absence.
6. The student is asked to be prepared for every following class according to the curriculum of the course. The Lecturer has the right to test the level of knowledge of the student in an oral or a written form.
7. If the student is not prepared for the classes, the Lecturer has the right to dismiss the student from the classes and determine the rules of completing the material covered during the classes.
8. The head of the course will be given an attendance list and a list of students who did not fulfill the above requirements of completing the course.
9. Using mobile phones and dictaphones during the classes is forbidden.
10. Copying the materials is forbidden.
11. A successful completion of the course is based on a credit on the basis of a written test – a single choice test. A pass credit – 70%.
